


Coloring peaceful waters will remind your students that just as Jesus calmed the storm and brought peace to His disciples, He can give them peace when they are afraid.

## What You Need

- ⇒ boats and verses from page 87
- ⇒ small paper plates
- ⇒ craft stick
- ⇒ crayons
- ⇒ scissors
- ⇒ glue



## Before Class

Duplicate the boat and verse from page 87 for each child. Make a sample craft to use in telling the story.

## What To Do

- 1. Give each student a boat to color and cut out. Have them glue the craft stick to the back of the boat, extending from the bottom.
- 2. Instruct the children to color the paper plate to look like water with peaceful waves.
- 3. Help the children fold the plate so there is a 1" space in the middle.
- 4. Cut a slit in the middle space for the craft stick. Allow the children to open the plate again then push the end of the craft stick through the slit until the boat sits on the water.
- 5. Give the students a verse to cut out and glue to the middle of the waves.

The water looks calm, doesn't it? But just minutes before Jesus calmed the waters, the disciples were hanging on, fearful they were drowning. All they had to do was ask Jesus for help. When your heart is afraid, ask Jesus for peace.
